

Contract for School Health Services
Sun Medical Care
Waterford-Halfmoon Union Free School District
July 1, 2021- June 30, 2022

The following outlines the requirements for School Health Services:

A. The School Physician will be a qualified physician, or a nurse practitioner to the extent authorized by Article 139 of the Education law and consistent with the written practice agreement pursuant to Education Law, section 6902(3), who is duly licensed pursuant to applicable law, and who is employed by the school district as an independent contractor to perform any duties conferred on the school physician or school medical inspector under any provision of law, to perform and coordinate the provision of health services in the district schools, and to provide health appraisals of students attending the schools in the district.

B. The School Physician will provide services as an independent contractor, through an established private medical practice; the District does not intend to and will not hire the individual.

C. The School Physician is expected to provide the following services: 1) Conduct annual health examinations, as required by Board policy and State statute, for all students who do not present a physician's certificate; 2) Conduct health examinations of students as required prior to their participation in school athletic programs; 3) Conduct health examinations of teachers and other employees, as directed by the Board of Education; and bus drivers as required by DMV regulations; 4) Serve as a member of the School District's Committee on Special Education in accordance with the New York State Education Law and the Federal Individuals with Disabilities Education Act; 5) Recommendations with respect to the exclusion or readmission of students suffering from or exposed to infectious or contagious disease; 6) Conduct health examinations of students on their return to school after exclusion because of a reportable infectious disease, if they do not present a certificate from their personal physician or the Town Health Office; 7) Sign-off on AED and other required documentation; 8) Review and revise, upon the request of the School District, health literature used in the schools of the District; 9) Performance of such other duties of a school physician as may, from time to time, be described in bulletins of the State Education Department, and such other duties consistent with the physician's professional status and qualification as the Board of Education may from time to time require. It is anticipated that approximately 60 hours will be required during the school year. Physicals are usually scheduled between 9:00 - 11:00am on school days. Sport physicals are given in early June and during the summer for approximately 1 day.


D. The individual or medical practice shall maintain professional liability insurance (malpractice insurance) in the minimum amount of \$1,000,000 for a single claim and \$3,000,000 per year aggregate for all professional services performed by the individual or medical practice for services to the district. This insurance will be maintained in full force and effect at all times. Proof of Workers Compensation and Disability insurance as required by New York State Law.

E. The period of the School Physician's contract will be one school year, commencing July 1st and ending June 30th. The contract may be renewed for successive one-year periods by the mutual agreement of the parties. The 2021 - 2022 contract is a flat fee of \$160 per hour for 60 hours of work annually. Please bill the Waterford-Halfmoon UFSD monthly for \$800. Any hours in excess will be filled separately with a detailed invoice at the end of the fiscal year June 30, 2022. Additional hours will be filled at \$175/hours.


