## STUDENT REGISTRATION GUIDELINES

(page 1 of 2)

• TWO forms of Proof of Residency are required before a student will be registered. Items reflecting a P.O. Box are not valid proof of residency. All items must be dated within the last 30 days.

Proof of residency consists of a bill or statement with your current name and home address pre-printed on it. You must provide **TWO** from the list below.

- Copy of signed lease; deed; or mortgage statement
- Statement by third party landlord, owner, or tenant from whom the parent/guardian lease from or live with
- Such other statement(s) by a third party establishing the physical presence of the parent/guardian in the school district
- Pav stub
- Income tax form
- Utility or other bills (within 30 days)
- Membership documents based upon residency (e.g., library cards)
- Voter registration document
- o Official driver's license, learner's permit, or non-driver ID
- State or other government issued identification
- Documents issued by federal, state, or local agencies
- Evidence of custody of the child, including but not limited to judicial custody orders or guardianship papers
- Proof of Identity for Parent/Guardian <u>is required before a student will be registered</u>.

The parent/guardian registering the student(s) must provide valid photo identification. The following items are accepted:

- Valid state issued driver's license or non-driver's Identification
- Original passport
- Valid NYS work-issued photo identification

- Proof of Date of Birth <u>is required before a student will be registered</u>. The following items are accepted:
  - Original birth certificate
  - Record of baptism
  - Original passport

## Altenate forms are requested if above documents are not available:

- Student's valid state issued driver's license
- State or other government issued identification
- School photo identification with date of birth
- Consulate identification card
- Hospital or health records
- Military dependent identification card
- o Documents issued by federal, state, or local agencies
- Court orders or other court-issued documents
- Native American tribal documents
- o Records from non-profit international aid agencies and voluntary agenceis
- Record of Immunizations: Proof of required immunizations is requested at registration. If the
  information is not available at the time of registration, a student may enter school; however
  immunization information <u>must be submitted within 14 days</u> to the school. Students
  entering from another state or country have 30 days to submit proof of immunizations.
  Incoming kindergarten students must be fully immunized prior to starting school with a signed
  document from your physician on file in the school nurse's office.
- School Records/Transcripts: These documents are required for proper grade placement.
  - o **Transcripts –** most up to date, official transcripts for secondary students
  - o Current Schedule most current schedule for secondary students
  - Report Card latest report card for elementary students
  - o IEP (Individual Education Plan) if applicable
  - \*\*\*Please note that your child's placement for school <u>may be delayed</u> if you do not bring the above information with you.
- Proof of Guardianship:
  - 1. Registering parent's name listed on the student's birth certificate
  - 2. Court papers if granting custody

## Important Note Regarding Release of Students from School:

The school district shall presume that either parent of a student has authority to obtain the child's release from school. However, a student shall not be released to a non-custodial parent if the district has been provided with a certified copy of a legally binding instrument, such as a court order or decree of divorce, separation or custody, that indicates the non-custodial parent does not have the right to obtain such release.
